### Eligibility

Each team will be made up of two youth members and one adult. Youth must be current members of 4-H or FFA to participate. 3<sup>rd</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade youth are eligible. Adult team member must be over 18 years old, and not a current 4-H or FFA member. Junior Cattlemen members may be in a group of three without an adult member. Youth participants are allowed to be on multiple teams.

### Contest Fees

\$30 per team. Max of 10 teams. Paid to the Harrison County Cattlemen's Association.

## Harrison County Cattlemen's Association Working Chute Contest Rules

**Date:** Sat, June 15, 2019    **Time:** Approx. 6:00PM    **Location:** 4-H Show Pavilion

### Contest Rules

1. Each team will work three head of cattle (approx. 200-600lbs) from a holding pen into a working chute and properly capture each animal's neck in the head gate. After the animal is caught, all the instructed health management products and practices will be administered by the team.
2. Each team will be responsible for the preparation of each product, for example:
  - a. Loading syringes
  - b. Loading ear tagger
  - c. Preparing pour-on
  - d. Preparing drench
  - e. Specific products will be announced at the contest
3. Only equipment provided by the Cattlemen's Association Contest Committee will be allowed.
4. Each team will be timed to see who can complete their tasks properly on three head of cattle in the least amount of time.
5. Penalty time can be assigned as follows:
  - a. Improper application or administration of a product – 10 seconds
  - b. Failure to apply or administer a product – 30 seconds
  - c. Rough or harsh treatment of an animal – 30 seconds
  - d. Use of any equipment other than that which is provided by the committee- 3 minutes
  - e. Failure to catch a calf resulting in it escaping through the chute without being stopped- team disqualification
  - f. A calf caught in the head gate other than at the neck must be released and re-caught properly at the neck. Failure to do so will result in team disqualification.
6. Disqualification will result if the judges agree that total processing is unsatisfactory or that a potentially dangerous situation exists.

### **Waiver, Release, Hold Harmless and Consent**

Furthermore, I hereby grant full permission to the sponsors of the Activity to use my name and likeness, as well as any photographs and any record of this event in which I may appear for any legitimate purpose, including advertising and promotion of the Activity or any similar events in the future.
